## DIRECTION FOR USE

## **PROCEDURE #1**

### SURFACE TO BE CLEANED

Loading docks, storage area floors and other floors with forklift truck circulation.

SOILS TO BE REMOVED

Food deposits, rubber marks from forklift truck wheels, many other types of stubborn deposits. USE PROCEDURE

Remove all loose soil. Wet floor and sprinkle with **WEST FLOORKLEEN**. Allow to dwell 20 to 30 minutes then brush with a hard bristled broom. Rinse with high-pressure hot water. CONCENTRATION As is.

#### TEMPERATURE

Preferably, rinse water should be at a minimum of 50°C. DWELL TIME / OPERATION TIME 20 to 30 minutes. MECHANICAL ACTION Brush and/or rinse using high-pressure hot water. RINSING Rinse with high or low pressure hot water.

REUSE/RECYCLING Not applicable.

## **PROCEDURE #2**

#### SURFACE TO BE CLEANED Lightly soiled floors.

SOILS TO BE REMOVED Food deposits, rubber marks from forklift truck wheels, etc. USE PROCEDURE Remove all loose soil. Wet floor with a hot solution of WEST FLOORKLEEN. Allow to dwell 10 to 15 minutes then brush with a hard bristled broom. Rinse with high-pressure hot water. CONCENTRATION 2% to 5% (v/v)

TEMPERATÚRE

Preferably, rinse water should be at a minimum of 60°C. DWELL TIME / OPERATION TIME 15 to 20 minutes. MECHANICAL ACTION Brush and/or rinse using high-pressure hot water. RINSING Rinse with high or low pressure hot water. REUSE/RECYCLING Not applicable.
