For the best results, the surface should be cleaned with **AccuCLEAN VLP**, before applying **AccuSHINE VLP**.

| Use procedure | Spray full strength AccuSHINE VLP onto surfaces then wipe with a clean, damp cloth to the spread polish evenly. Dilute before applying to leather and vinyl seats, to prevent any slippery feeling afterwards. |
| Concentration | Full strength for vinyl and plastic surfaces except seats. Dilute 3:1 with warm or cold water before spraying on seats. |
| Use temperature | Dilute with warm or cold water as needed. |
| Rinsing | Wipe area with a clean, damp cloth to spread polish evenly. No rinsing is needed. |
