# DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**Use procedure** 

Spray full strength **AccuShine VLP** onto surfaces then wipe with a clean, damp cloth to the spread polish evenly. Dilute before applying to leather and vinyl seats, to prevent any slippery feeling afterwards.

Concentration

Full strength for vinyl and plastic surfaces except seats.

Dilute 3:1 with warm or cold water before spraying on seats.

**Use temperature** 

Dilute with warm or cold water as needed.

Rinsing

Wipe area with a clean, damp cloth to spread polish evenly. No rinsing is needed.
