DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use procedure	To maximize effectiveness, clean soiled surfaces with AccuSolve 808 before proceeding with water-based cleaning procedures.
Concentration	For optimal results, use AccuSOLVE 808 at full strength.
Dwell time/Operation time	If dealing with heavy deposits, consider extended soaking times along with brushing or spraying.
Use temperature	AccuSOLVE 808 is ideal for cold degreasing applications. Do not use on hot surfaces.
Rinsing	Rinse thoroughly with high-pressure water as needed.
