Parts and equipment can be easily cleaned by spraying, brushing, or soaking with **AccuSOLVE 875**. This product is ready to use and more cost effective than typical cold degreasing solvents.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use procedure	AccuSOLVE 875 can be used at full strength for dried heavier deposits and may be diluted for lighter cleaning requirements. For greater effectiveness it is best to clean with AccuSOLVE 875 prior to aqueous washing procedures. Some brushing and extended soaking times may be required to remove heavy deposits.
Concentration	As is.
Use temperature	AccuSOLVE 875 is ideal for cold degreasing applications. Do not use it on hot surfaces.
Rinsing	Rinse thoroughly with high-pressure water as needed.

FIRST AID MEASURES
