**AccuSolve CC-50** is readily biodegradable and has a more pleasant odor compared to traditional petroleum distillate cleaning solvents such as varsol.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

### Use procedure

**AccuSolve CC-50** should be used at full strength. Parts and equipment can be easily cleaned by spraying, brushing or soaking with **AccuSolve CC-50**. Vigorous brushing or extended soaking may be required for very heavy deposits. After the soil has been loosened the parts should be flushed with fresh solvent then allowed to air dry.

### Concentration

For the best cleaning results or for heavy deposits use **AccuSolve CC-50** full strength.
