DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use procedure	To maximize effectiveness, clean soiled surfaces with AccuSOLVE before proceeding with water-based cleaning procedures.
Concentration	Most effective when used undiluted. May also be emulsified in water for immediate use with lighter cleaning tasks such as film removal or spot cleaning.
Dwell time/Operation time	If dealing with heavy deposits, consider extended soaking times along with brushing or spraying.
Use temperature	AccuSOLVE is ideal for cold degreasing applications. Do not use on hot surfaces.
Rinsing	Rinse thoroughly with high-pressure water as needed.

FIRST AID MEASURES
