### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

<b>Use procedure</b>	Add <b>COVERALL CLEANER</b> directly in the washing machine drum before adding work wear to ensure detergent dissolves completely.
<b>Concentration</b>	Use 1 to 1.5 cups of <b>COVERALL CLEANER</b> per full wash load. Light soiled work wear can be cleaned with lower doses of detergent. Always read and follow the garment care instructions printed on the coveralls being cleaned
<b>Use temperature</b>	<b>COVERALL CLEANER</b> can be used in both hot and cold-water. For best results, wash garments with warm or hot water.
<b>Rinsing</b>	Rinse with cold water.

## FIRST AID MEASURES

### Ingestion

Do not induce vomiting unless directed by medical personnel. Rinse mouth with water and drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician immediately.
