DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use procedure

Add **COVERALL CLEANER** directly in the washing machine drum before adding work wear to ensure detergent dissolves completely.

Concentration

Use 1 to 1.5 cups of **COVERALL CLEANER** per full wash load. Light soiled work wear can be cleaned with lower doses of detergent. Always read and follow the garment care instructions printed on the coveralls being cleaned

Use temperature

COVERALL CLEANER can be used in both hot and cold-water. For best results, wash garments with warm or hot water.

Rinsing

Rinse with cold water.

FIRST AID MEASURES
