DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Technique

Using a cloth, test the product on a small area to determine the surface durability and the ideal contact time. Do not use if the surface appears altered after the test application. Apply the product undiluted with a brush or a roller on the surface to be cleaned. Repeat if necessary, on a dry surface.

Concentration

Undiluted.

Dwell time/Operation time

1 to 10 minutes. Do not let the product dry.

Mechanical action

Scrub if necessary. Be careful, may damage paint or certain surfaces near the area to be treated.

Rinsing

Rinse with cold water using a wet scrubbing pad, a cloth, or high pressure water.
