DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use procedure

Use **EQUALIZER** for fabric pre-treatment or add via manual addition or injection pump system directly to wash cycle. For optimum results, use in combination with West Penetone laundry care products.

Concentration

Between 115 to 230 ml or approximately 1/2 to 1 cup per *single* wash load. Between 230 to 460 ml or approximately 1 to 2 cups per *triple* wash load.

Effective in both hot and cold water.
