**FOAMWAX** is ideally incorporated in the premium level wash package where it provides a brightly colored (red, yellow or blue), cherry fragranced foam on the vehicle surface, while depositing a thin water repelling, glossy film.

**FOAMWAX** will produce a dense foam when properly applied through an aerating applicator system. The water repelling film left on the vehicle surface improves the gloss and overall appearance.

# DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**Use procedure** 

**FoamWax** should be diluted with water applied using compressed-air, foam generating equipment after rinsing all detergent from the vehicle surface.

Concentration

**FOAMWAX** is typically diluted 80:1 to 120:1 with water. This dilution should be adjusted as required to give the best visual appearance during application.

Use temperature

Hot or warm water

Rinsing

Rinse with hot or cold water, or apply high pressure spray wax solution.
