DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use procedure	Use GLISTEN as directed. May be used manually or with adequate foaming or high-pressure systems. Scour or brush stubborn deposits.
Concentration	Between 1%-10%, depending on type of re-circulating system and amount of soils present.
Use temperature	Most effective in hot, soft water.
Dwell time/Operation time	Allow to dwell 3 to 5 minutes before final rinsing.
Mechanical action	Scrubbing, high pressure application and rinsing recommended for removing stubborn deposits.
Rinsing	High pressure hot water.

IMPORTANT

FIRST AID MEASURES

Ingestion

Eye contact

Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: get medical advice/attention.
