DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use procedures

Surface to be cleaned	Recommended dilution	Procedure	
Anilox System (Flush)	1:1 - 1:10	Place solution in ink pot and flush thoroughly through the system. Rinse with water.	
Top Print & Bottom Press Rolls	1:5 - 1:10	Wipe or spray with solution. Wipe off with clean, damp cloth.	
Press Exterior	1:5 - 1:10	Wipe or spray with solution. Wipe off with clean, damp cloth.	
Dies	1:5 - 1:10	Wipe or spray with solution. Wipe off with clean, damp cloth.	
Floors	1:1 - 1:10	Apply with mop, agitate. Remove with a clean mop or wet vac.

IMPORTANT

FIRST AID MEASURES
