## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use procedures

VOC (method 24) 100%, 750 lbs/gal., 900gms/l

For the removal of hardened inks and adhesives, apply **GRAFIKLEEN R845** by coarse spray or rag and allow to dwell for a short time. Some brushing or agitation may be necessary in areas with a heavy build-up.

Remove **GRAFIKLEEN R845** by wiping area with either a dry rag or mop. In some instances, a rag or a mop slightly saturated with **GRAFIKLEEN R845** may be beneficial.

GRAFIKLEEN R845 can also be used in immersion cleaning. Temperatures should not exceed 43°C.
