#### Use procedure

#### GREASE TRAP

**PROZYME GT** can be poured manually into the trap or injected with an automatic dispensing system. Dosage may vary depending on the size of the trap and soil load. Contact your local West Penetone sales representative for the necessary equipment and dosage rates for your grease trap.

#### DRAINS

Pour product at a rate of 4 – 8 oz or approximately 120 - 240 ml or approximately 1/2 – 1 cup per week directly into the drain.

NOTE: performance may be affected in pH conditions under 5 or over 9.8.
