Techniques

Concentration

Stock solution:

Clean out water pipe with FOAMCHEK before applying QUADRACID.

Mix 10 ml of liquid acidifier in 1 litre of potable water.

Working solution: With a metering pump, use 1 part of stock solution with 100 parts of water. (1:100).

IMPORTANT

FIRST AID MEASURES

Eye contact

Do not induce vomiting. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water. Call a physician or Poison Control Centre immediately. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
