DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use procedure

Use **SEA SPRAY** for fabric pre-treatment or add via manual addition or injection pump system directly to wash cycle. For optimum results, use in combination with West Penetone line of laundry care products.

Concentration

Between 114 to 227 ml or approximately 1/2 to 1 cup per 50 lb load.
Up to 4% v/v with water for pre-soak operations.
Up to 20% v/v with water for pre-spray applications.

Use temperature

Effective in both hot and cold water.
