# HIGH FOAMING BRUSH-WASH DETERGENT

**TRUFOAM** is a high-foaming, near-neutral, and strongly colored liquid detergent designed specifically for carwash applications. It can be used in wand wash foamy-brush cycles and in tunnel-wash systems featuring either conventional rotating brushes, or the newer "soft cloth" process. **TRUFOAM** is available as red, blue and yellow options.

When applied, **TRUFOAM** generates large volumes of thick, brightly coloured, lubricating foam that effectively lift road grime from the vehicle's surface. The foam's gentle action ensures thorough cleaning, leaving the customer with a pristine and sparkling clean car.

# DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use procedure	Use <b>TRUFOAM</b> for foam brush cycle in wand wash operations or to lubricate the rotating brush/soft cloth in tunnel wash systems.
Concentration	500:1 for rotating brush/soft-cloth cycle of tunnel wash systems. 60 to 100:1 for foamy brush cycle in wand wash.
Use temperature	Can be used in both hot and cold-water cleaning applications. For best results, use hot water $(50^{\circ}C - 60^{\circ}C / 120^{\circ}F - 140^{\circ}F)$ .
Rinsing	High pressure hot water is recommended.

## PHYSICAL PROPERTIES



### IMPORTANT

Before using **TRUFOAM** always be sure to read and follow precautions and directions for use appearing on the product's container label, and on the safety data sheet (S.D.S).

# FIRST AID MEASURES

### Ingestion

Do not induce vomiting unless directed by medical personnel. Rinse mouth with water and drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician if you feel unwell.

### Skin contact

Take off contaminated clothing and rinse skin with plenty of water. If skin irritation occurs, get medical advice/attention. Wash any contaminated clothing before re-use.

### Inhalation

If difficulties occur after mist, vapors, or spray has been inhaled, remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician if you feel unwell.

### Eye contact

Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician immediately.
