DIRECTION FOR USE

Use procedure

Clean out water pipe with **PREMISE ACID** before applying **WEST ACID** R.

Concentration

Stock solution: Between 1 % and 5 % (10 ml to 50 ml/litre of water) Working solution: With a metering pump use 1 part of stock solution with 100 part of drinking water (1:100).

Temperature

Avoid extreme temperatures.

IMPORTANT

FIRST AID MEASURES

Eye contact
