WEST B-3204

Additive for steam treatment

WEST B-3204 contains a morpholine and cyclohexylamine mixture of neutralizing amines.

The distribution ratio of the **WEST B-3204** can vary from low to medium, depending on the operating pressure of the boiler.

The use of the **WEST B-3204** is recommended in steam boilers with a condensate return ratio greater than 80% and / or with boilers equipped with a dealkalization system.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Techniques

It is recommended to inject **WEST B-3204** into the make-up water tank or into the steam collector. If the product is used diluted, then it is recommended to use softened water or water from condensate returns for making the dilution.

Sufficient WEST B-3204 must be injected to maintain the pH in the vapor lines between 7.5 and 8.5.

If the deoxygenation and boiler feed conditions are known, then your West Penetone representative can approximate the volumes of **WEST B-3204** consumed by your boiler.

MPORTANT

FIRST AID MEASURES

Eye contact
