### DIRECTION FOR USE

#### Technique

Pump soap onto moistened hands and work into a creamy lather. Rub hands vigorously for at least 20 seconds to clean thoroughly and wash away bacteria. Rinse hands thoroughly with potable water prior to handling food.

#### Rinsing

Potable water must be used at all times (Warm if possible). Do not leave product residue on hands.
