DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use procedure	For dishwasher systems, apply via automatic dispenser. For disinfection and sanitation, use chlorine test papers to ensure and verify that it is being used at the appropriate concentration.
Concentration	For all applications, use at a rate of 5-6 ml per liter of wash fluid.
Use temperature	Cold water is recommended.
