DIRECTION FOR USE

Equipment to be treated	Agricultural and horticultural equipment, floors, walls, etc.
Soils to be removed	Animal fat, protein, organic vegetal deposits, boot marks, etc.
Use procedure	Manually remove a maximum of soil. Rinse surfaces with water (high-pressure, and hot if possible) then apply WESTKLEEN 4115 manually or with a foamer.
Concentration	Between 1% and 5% (20 ml and 50 ml/litre of water).
Temperature	Between 5°C and 60°C (41 and 140°F).
Contact time	Between 5 and 25 minutes.
Mechanical action	Scrubbing recommended.
Rinsing	Rinse all food-contact surfaces with potable water (Hot water if possible).
Reuse/recycling	No.

IMPORTANT

FIRST AID MEASURES
