DIRECTION FOR USE

Equipment to be cleaned Food and beverage equipment, floors, walls, etc...

Soils to be removed Animal fat, protein, organic vegetal deposits, boot marks, etc...

Use procedure Remove a maximum of soil manually. Rinse surfaces with water (high-pressure, and hot if possible) then apply **WESTKLEEN 4115** manually or with a foamer.

Concentration 1% to 5% (10 ml to 50 ml per litres of water).

Use Temperature 5°C to 60°C (60 to 140°F).

Dwell time/Operation time 1 to 25 minutes.

Mechanical action Scrubbing will enhance the result.

Rinsing Rinse all food-contact surfaces with potable water.
