### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

#### Use procedure

Spray surface with **WESTLODE** as is or diluted, according to the nature of the deposit. Allow to dwell for 5 to 30 minutes then remove with cloth or rinse with water.

#### Concentration

As is or diluted with water up to 1:10, according to degree of difficulty.

#### Use temperature

Ambiant.

#### Dwell time/Operation time

Between 5 and 30 minutes, according to degree of difficulty.

#### Mechanical action

Scrubbing or rinsing with high pressure water is recommended.

#### Rinsing

Cold water.

#### Reuse/recycling

Not always possible.
