WESTRIP V-120 is designed to remove carbonized and other baked on deposits from conventional or convection ovens, rotisseries and other equipment found in food processing plants.

WESTRIP V-120 is an extremely powerful product which acts fast on carbonized deposits with a minimum of scrubbing.

DIRECTION FOR USE

Equipment to be cleaned

Ovens, rotisseries, small smokehouses.

Soils to be removed

Carbonized and protein deposits that are baked or dried on, cooking oils and greases.

Technique

Apply product to cold surface with a plastic pad or paintbrush with polyester bristles. Allow to dwell for a few minutes then scrub with a pad and rinse with hot water using a pad or wet cloth. Repeat operation if soils are stubborn.

NOTE: Avoid using **WEST V-120** on hot surfaces since it evaporates quickly leaving undesirable chemical residues. Also, avoid using paintbrushes with conventional bristles.

Concentration

As is.

Temperature

Ambient.

Dwell time/Operation time

5 to 15 minutes.

Mechanical action

Scrubbing with pad or cloth, after dwell time, is usually enough.

Rinsing

Rinse with hot water, using a pad or wet cloth.

IMPORTANT

FIRST AID MEASURES
