DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Area of application

Interior of pipes, tanks or vessels requiring foulant removal and full decontamination.

Use procedure

Use **WESTSURF 10** as part of a circulation or vapor phase procedure.

May be used at concentrate when applied manually or diluted on-site up to 2-5% v/v when part of a chemical blend procedure.

When used as part of a water flush or steam injection, consult your West Penetone sales representative for further information.

Use temperature

60-80°C (140-176°F) is recommended.

Dwell time / Operation time

Dependent on job, site and method of application. Consult your West Penetone sales representative for further information.

FIRST AID MEASURES

Ingestion
